Eastern Screech-Owl – Jake's landing, Tuckahoe, West Cape May area, 5th Ave marsh in West Cape May

Great Horned Owl – Stipson's Island, Cape Island

Barred Owl – Rea Farm, Pine Swamp Rd (Belleplain)

Common Nighthawk – Pond Creek Marsh, Meadows

Chuck-will's-widow – CM Airport, Pond Creek Marsh, Heislerville

Whip-poor-will – Belleplain, Jake's Landing, Tuckahoe area

Ruby-throated Hummingbird – CMBO Goshen

Belted Kingfisher – Nummy Island free bridge, Corson's Inlet State Park, Cape May Point, Reed's Beach

Rough-winged Swallow – CMP State Park (bunker), Bayshore Rd at canal, Meadows

Bank Swallow – Sumner Ave pee fields, flyby at Cape May Pt

Cliff Swallow – Cape May Pt, Brig

Red-breasted Nuthatch – Coral and Harvard Cape May Pt, Northwood, Higbee

White-breasted Nuthatch – Belleplain, Cox Hall Creek

Marsh Wren – Jakes Landing, Stipsons Island

Blue-gray Gnatcatcher – Belleplain, Beanery

Ruby-crowned Kinglet – Belleplain, Cox Hall Creek WMA, Beanery, Cold Spring Campground, Higbee

Eastern Bluebird – Brig, Sunset Rd Belleplaine, school west of Mauricetown, 2 at Higbee yesterday, 2 at flower farm near Sheep Farm at Belleplaine

Veery – Highland Motor Inn, flyovers, Belleplaine

Gray-cheeked Thrush – early, but listen at night

Swainson's Thrush – Beaver Swamp WMA

Wood Thrush – Belleplaine, Cox Hall Creek, CM Airport, Higbee

Brown Thrasher – Brig, Higbee, dunes at Cape May Pt and Meadows

American Pipit – flyovers at Cape May Pt

Cedar Waxwing – Mannington marsh, flybys at Cape May Point, Higbee

Worm-eating Warbler – Cox Hall Creek WMA, Belleplaine (Narrows Rd)

Louisiana Waterthrush – Belleplaine

Northern Waterthrush – Cox Hall Creek WMA, Beanery, 5th Ave West Cape May

Blue-winged Warbler – Weatherby Rd, James Moor Rd (Cumberland County), Higbee in past few days, Belleplaine recently

Prothonotary Warbler – Belleplaine, 2 pairs at Beanery, Dividing Creek

Nashville Warbler – Jake's landing, Cox Hall Creek WMA

Kentucky Warbler – Fort Apache (Fulling Mill Rd, Rio Grande area)

Hooded Warbler—Belleplaine, Fort Apache, 44th Street Avalon (migrant)

American Redstart – Cox Hall Creek WMA, Higbee, 1st Ave Peaslee

Cape May Warbler – flyovers at Cape May Pt

Northern Parula – Cox Hall Creek WMA, Higbee etc

Magnolia Warbler – Cox Hall Creek WMA, Higbee, Cape May Point

Bay-breasted Warbler – Beanery at back railroad tracks

Blackburnian Warbler – migrants at Cape Island

Yellow Warbler – Meadows, CMP State Park, Heislerville

Chestnut-sided Warbler – Langley Rd, near Willow Creek winery, Cox Hall Creek

Blackpoll Warbler – Cape Island, Heislerville, Cox Hall Creek WMA

Black-throated Blue Warbler – near Triangle Park CMP, Cox Hall Creek WMA

Palm Warbler – CMP State Park dunes

Pine Warbler – many in Belleplaine, CMP State Park, Cox Hall Creek WMA

Yellow-throated Warbler – Belleplaine

Prairie Warbler – Vine St., Belleplaine, Higbee

Black-throated Green Warbler – Beanery, Higbee, Cox Hall Creek WMA

Wilson's Warbler – Narrows Rd Belleplaine

Nelson's Sparrow – Jake's landing parking area, Two Mile Landing

Saltmarsh Sparrow – Two Mile Landing, Jake's Landing

Seaside Sparrow – Jake's landing, Stipson's Island

White-throated Sparrow – Beanery, Cox Hall Creek WMA, Higbee

White-crowned Sparrow – recent but not today on 5th Ave, West Cape May

Summer Tanager – Railroad Ave Cumberland County, Belleplaine (various spots), Fort Apache Park

Scarlet Tanager – Belleplaine, Stone Harbor Bird Sanctuary

Rose-breasted Grosbeak – Cape May Pt, Belleplaine, bird feeders

Blue Grosbeak – Cox Hall Creek WMA, Middle Twp bike path, Hidden Valley

Indigo Bunting – Beanery, Higbee, etc

Bobolink – Cape May Pt as flyovers, Pond Creek marsh

Eastern Meadowlarks – Featherbed Lane, Pee Fields at Belleplaine

Boat-tailed Grackle – Turkey Pt, Reed's Beach, Nummy

Baltimore Oriole – palmyra, Cape may Point, Higbee, Cox Hall

Pine Siskin – flyover at Cape May Point on Wednesday

Fork-tailed Flycatcher – Beanery

White Ibis – flyover at Parkway, Pond Creek marsh on Wednesday, report from Parkway mile 4 pond, Brig last week

White-faced Ibis – Rte 47 at mile 14.3 + Bayberry Rd ponds near car dealerships (Cape May Court House)

Brown-headed Nuthatch – Cape May Point (last week + Wednesday)

Swainson's Warbler – north end of Cape May Pt State Park (audible from Lighthouse Pond and Triangle Park)
